

SCHOOL:

The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been thoroughly risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection using the latest government guidance, scientific evidence and local data;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Ensure a clean physical environment which has been made as safe as possible;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's emotional and physical well-being, mental health and basic learning needs;
- Support the children in learning about keeping themselves and others around them safe;
- Isolate your child and contact you immediately if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19, or is otherwise unwell;
- Support families to access COVID-19 testing if this is needed;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;
- Seek further advice from Public Health officials in the event of a positive test linked with school;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, and email.

PARENT:

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get all of us tested and I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via email;
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately and we will quarantine the household for 14 days;
- On our commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- My child must not bring any personal items or equipment into school other than those specified, or take items home from school;
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child (and others) may not always do this successfully;
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not be allowed into any school building without a prearranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details.
- If my child's behaviour is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home immediately and cannot return to school until they can behave in a safe way in line with school expectations. They will access home learning.

CHILD:

I will do my best to:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school and only use the equipment provided to me or asked for by school and nothing else.
- I will only leave my workplace in the classroom when given permission to do so by a member of school staff;
- Not mix with any other children in other 'bubbles' while in the school and ensure social distancing in the community;
- Only enter and exit the school building from my designated entrance;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (**catch it-bin it-kill it**);
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser regularly and when reminded to do so;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can behave in a safe manner and follow school expectations.
