

## SCHOOL:

### The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been thoroughly risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection using the latest government guidance, scientific evidence and local data;
- Adhere to the current rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Ensure a clean physical environment which has been made as safe as possible;

- Seek further advice from Public Health officials in the event of any positive test linked with school and inform you of our outbreak management strategy if advised to do so;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, and email.
- Provide remote learning opportunities for pupils who are isolating

## PARENT:

### To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will follow the current guidance for testing/isolation and I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via email;
- I will remind my child about the current government guidance so that we can all continue to stay as safe as possible;
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene and I will remind them of this at home;
- I will not be allowed into the school building without a prearranged appointment and will make appointments via telephone or email;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to continue to keep an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child's behaviour is deemed not to meet expectations, he/she will have sanctions and may not be able to join in with some activities until they can behave in a safe way and in line with school expectations.
- I will ensure my child has the necessary uniform, PE and forest school clothing required to ensure they can learn and play comfortably and safely
- I will not allow my child to bring toys into school
- I will support my child to learn by listening to them read and/or enabling a quiet place for them to complete any homework as their age and stage of learning requires.
- I will speak to my child's teacher if we have any concerns or worries

- Tell an adult if I feel unwell, upset, worried or anxious about anything;
- Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school and only use the equipment provided to me or asked for by school and nothing else;
- Concentrate and try hard in all my activities and lessons;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (**catch it-bin it-kill it**);
- Follow good hand hygiene – using soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser regularly and when reminded to do so;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I may not be able to do some of the things I enjoy most until I can behave in a safe manner and follow school expectations.
