PARENT:

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details.
- The school will support my child to behave in a way that is appropriate to their age, stage of development and needs; that there may be sanctions and they may not be able to join in with some activities until they can behave in a safe way and in line with school expectations.
- I will ensure my child has the necessary uniform, PE and forest school clothing required to ensure they can learn and play comfortably and safely
- I will not allow my child to bring toys into school
- I will support my child to learn by listening to them read and/or enabling a quiet place for them to complete any homework as their age and stage of learning requires.
- I will speak to my child's teacher if I have any concerns or worries
- If my child is unwell, I will use my best judgement to decide if they should attend school. If they are not well enough, I will email the reason to the school on each morning of absence; and ensure my child returns to school as soon as they recover;
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene and I will remind them of this at home;
- I understand that I will not usually be allowed into the school building without a prearranged appointment and will make appointments via telephone or email;
- I need to support the school in their efforts to continue to keep the site safe for both safeguarding and safety purposes, and follow changes in procedure as required.
